

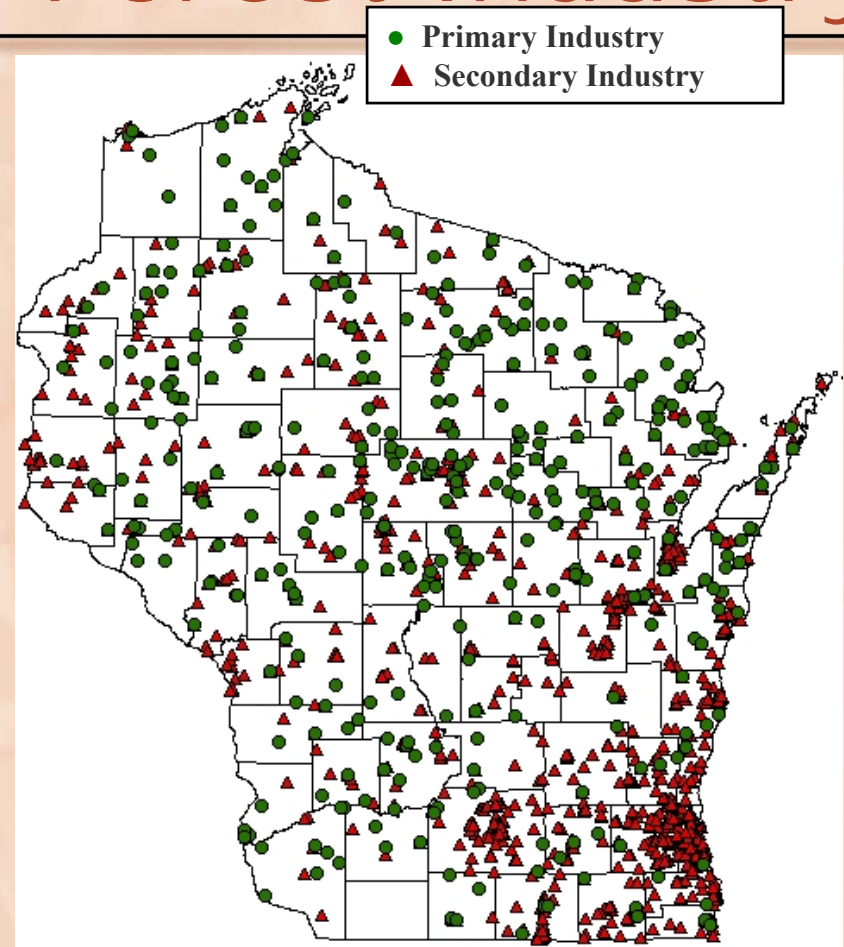


Wisconsin's Forest Industry

Wisconsin is the **#1 paper making state** in the nation and has been for 50 years.

Wisconsin's forest industry also ranks

- **first** in fine papers,
- **first** in sanitary paper products,
- **first** in millwork, and
- third in hardwood.



Primary forest product industries are those companies converting roundwood (logs) to wood products such as lumber or pulp & paper. The secondary industries are those making consumer products from the primary industry outputs.)



Theoretical Supply

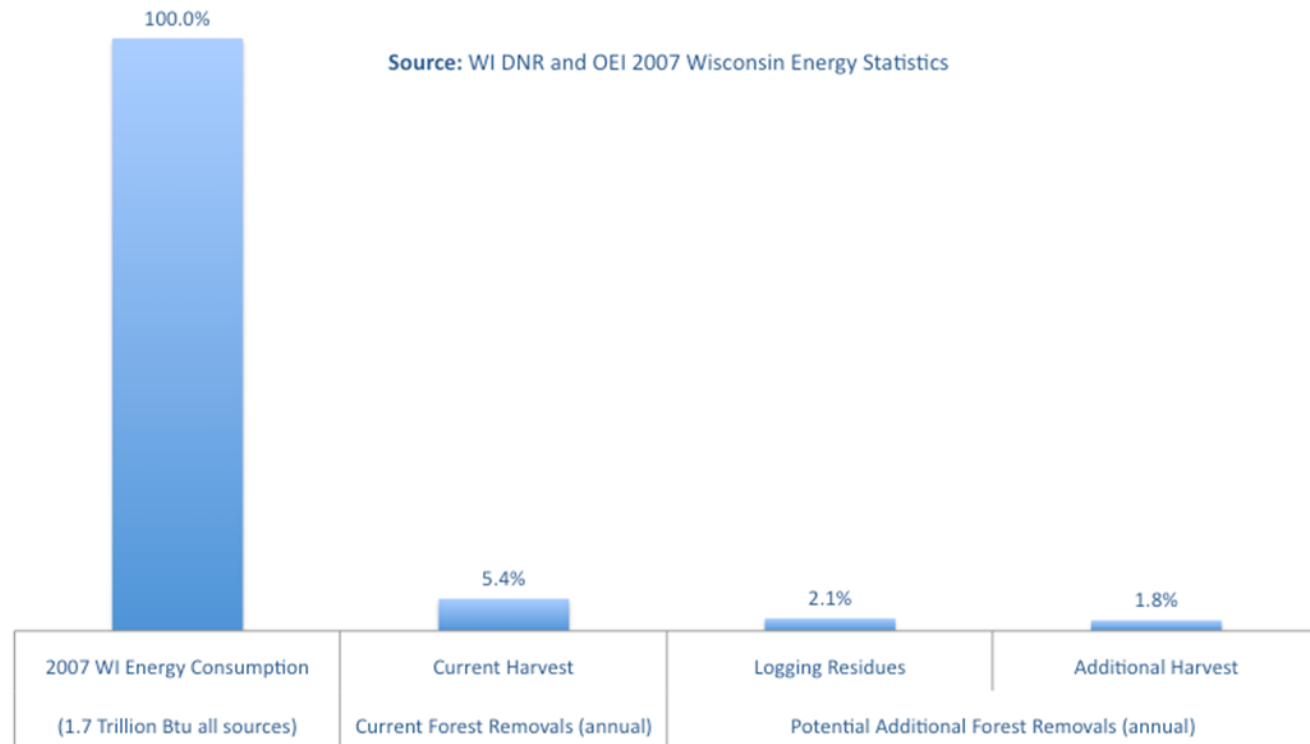
- 75% Annual Net Growth 6,425,759 d/t

- **Theoretical surplus 1,231,442 d/t**
